Biography

Edward Robie was born at Gorham, ME, in 1821. He graduated from Bowdoin College in 1840 and from Andover Theological Seminary in 1843. He studied in Germany during the next three years, at the universities of Halle and Berlin. When he returned to this country he taught ancient and modern languages at Gorham Academy, 1846-1848. He returned to Andover to become Librarian and Instructor of Sacred Literature at the Seminary, positions he held until 1851.

He was ordained to the Congregational ministry at Greenland, NH, February 25, 1852. He remained as pastor of the Greenland church until his death in 1917.

Scope and Content

The Edward Robie Papers document his professional work. Almost all material is undated, but it could be presumed that the manuscripts span his pastoral career at Greenland, NH, 1852-1917. The collection is arranged according to the following categories: autobiography (1868), European travel journal (1896), letters (2 items), sermons (arranged by biblical text), addresses, unpublished literary manuscripts, and book reviews (arranged in alphabetical order).
