The Getty Research Portal™ is a free online catalog of publications about art, artists, cultural history, and theory and criticism of art. Drawing from numerous art libraries and institutes, the portal contains over 86,000 titles. Included among these are [publications from the Online Scholarly Catalogue Initiative](#) [1], a Getty Foundation program that helps museums create multimedia, web-based collection catalogues.
