Additional access for other creators (7xx)

Although PCC Core requires that an access point be created only for the creator having principal responsibility named first in a resource or in reference sources, catalogers are encouraged to provide additional authorized access points for contributors (see table under the [100 field](#) [1]) – e.g., artists, publishers, printers, sponsors, etc.

Use relator codes to clarify the relationship:

Example:

100 1_ \$a Earlom, Richard, \$d 1743-1822, \$e printmaker.

245 10 \$a [The newlyweds at breakfast] : \$b engraved from the original plate / \$c painted by William Hogarth ; engraved by Richard Earlom.

700 1_ \$a Hogarth, William, \$d 1697-1764, \$e artist.

Yale Policy: Use the relator code 'printmaker' rather than 'etcher', 'engraver', 'metal-engraver', 'lithographer' or any of the other related terms that specify medium.

Suggested terms: attributed name, publisher, associated name.
