[Thesaurus of Geographic Names \(TGN\) \[5\]](#): TGN is a structured vocabulary, including names, descriptions, and other information for places important to art and architecture.

Thesaurus For Graphic Materials [11]: The *Thesaurus for Graphic Materials* is a tool for indexing visual materials by subject and by genre/format. The thesaurus includes more than 7,000 subject terms (coded lctgm) and 650 genre/format terms (coded gmGPC) to index types of photographs, prints, design drawings, ephemera, and other pictures. In 2007, the subject and genre/format vocabularies, previously maintained separately, were merged into a single list.

[Union List of Artists' Names \(ULAN\): \[12\]](#)ULAN is a structured vocabulary, including names, biographies, and other information about artists and architects.

Virtual International Authority File (VIAF): [13] A joint project with the Library of Congress, the Deutsche Nationalbibliothek, and the Bibliothèque nationale de France, in cooperation with an expanding number of other national libraries and other agencies, VIAF explores virtually combining the name authority files of participating institutions into a single name authority service.
