Yale University Library has been offered trials for two Chinese language databases: Chinese Periodical Full-text Database-Late Qing Series, 1833-1911 and Apabi Full-text Newspapers.

<u>Chinese Periodical Full-text Database-Late Qing Series, 1833-1911</u> [1] (?????????, 1833-1911) is provided by the Shanghai Library. The database includes 302 most important journals in this period. During the trial period, only 100 articles are allowed to be downloaded.

Apabi Full-text Newspapers [2] include 26 most important Chinese language newspapers published in China. In addition to including a full-run of the Southern Weekly (????) from 1984–present, the package also covers titles such as Global Times (????), Liberation Army Daily (????), and People's Court News (?????). The coverage of the back issues for each newspaper varies.
