Introduction

A unique archive

The Archives of the Council for World Mission (incorporating the archives of the London Missionary Society) are among the oldest archives on missionary work, with files of correspondence and travel reports dating back to the eighteenth century. This material is now housed in the Library of the School of Oriental and African Studies, London. The special value of these archives lies in the wealth of unpublished historical source material pertaining to colonial countries of Africa, Asia, and South America. One of the rare treasures, for instance, is the collection of 115 original letters - with a considerable number of insertions - written by David Livingstone, together with copies of letters sent to him.

Many of the records of the London Missionary Society date back to the foundation of the Society in 1795. They include Board Minutes (from 1795 to date), Committee Minutes (incomplete), copies of memorials from the Society to governments (1856-1931), reports (incomplete), correspondence (official and personal), diaries kept by missionaries in the field, and miscellaneous material. The journals, the early correspondence, and some of the minutes and miscellaneous papers have been catalogued. Much of the correspondence and committee-minutes files are still uncatalogued, but this work is in progress.

Notes on the archives

The Committee Minutes, to the extent that they refer to the different areas of countries, are always filmed before the material for each area, to facilitate use of that material.

The *Odds* and *Personal* material related to the various areas appears to have been made up as it came to hand and the numbering is not chronological. A brief indication of the contents is given in the inventory lists.

With reference to the *Correspondence* in the Archives:

- a. Up to and including 1927, incoming and outgoing letters were kept separately.
- b. The *outgoing* material is in copy books, and these are arranged chronologically. The majority of the outgoing material from 1914 onward was lost due to bomb damage.
- c. *Incoming* letters up to and including 1927 were kept in chronological order. For the *earliest* material, a table of contents was provided in each box, and copies of these tables of contents are

contained in the series of inventories. These give a generally accurate picture, but in some boxes there are hand-written tables of contents which were not copied and inserted in the inventories.

d. The *second-stage* material is in date order with a précis sheet attached to the letters in most cases. The précis gives a brief indication of the subject matter.

e. From 1928 on, the *incoming and outgoing* correspondence is given together in personal and subject files arranged alphabetically.

Inventories on microfiche

Direct and precise access to part of the Archives is provided by 34 detailed inventories which carry the microfiche numbers listed in the margins. These inventories are part of the complete microfiche collection but can also be bought separately at 357 Dutch guilders. (Order no. LA-744/1)
